



Horse Shows

Clients are expected to complete their own entries, those filled out by the trainer will be charged \$10 per horse.

Unpaid bills by clients at the show, paid by SFS, will have a \$10 service fee added to their statement.

Show Care (load/unload, water, hay, feed, stall cleaning), charged daily from day of departure until day of return.

Show Rules:

- **Team sportsmanship is MANDATORY! Poor sportsmanship will not be tolerated.**
- **Take your ribbon (regardless of color) or take your loss graciously.**
- **Clean schooling and show pads are required.**
- **Horse must be clipped and cleaned.**
- **Show clothes, helmet and boots must be clean.**
- **Clean tack (saddle, girth, bridle, martingale) is mandatory.**
- **NEVER enter the arena unless directed to do so by your instructor.**
- **Remember to have fun and enjoy your experience!**

Barn Rules

- Please be on time and ready for your lesson.
- Helmets and appropriate footwear are required at all times when mounted & getting horses up.
- Children should be supervised at all times and under no circumstance should they be dropped off without permission of management.
- Riders under the age of 12 are not permitted to ride without the direct supervision of an adult or “buddy”.
- Absolutely NO jumping of horses is allowed without the direct supervision of an instructor.
- Unsafe riders, endangering the safety of other riders or animals will not be tolerated.
- ALL riders are responsible for cleaning up after themselves. This includes tack and equipment.
- We highly recommend that ALL personal tack and equipment be clearly and permanently marked.
- If you open it, close it. If you use it, clean it. If you break it, fix it (or let someone know it’s broken). If you don’t know, just ask. If you get it out, put it away.
- Be polite and courteous.
- The barn managers office, feed room and loft are strictly off limits.
- Permission by the owner must be given before equipment or tack is borrowed.
- Do not interrupt a lesson. If you need assistance, ask the barn staff.
- Clean all tack and equipment used for your lesson and put it away.
- If you rent a locker, keep all your personal items in the locker. Any items on the floor will be put in impound.
- Use the “buddy-system” when going on a trail ride. Never ride alone and always let management know when you’re going out.
- No riding is permitted inside the barn.
- Do NOT feed treats to the horses without owner permission.
- Throw away your trash !
- If something seems unsafe or not right, let us know!

Fee Schedule

\$40 Service charge for all NFS checks. Board is due the 1st of the month and becomes delinquent on the 15th. A fee of \$25 per day will be added for delinquent payments and added to the next months statement.

Stall Board (\$ Standard/ \$ Full) <i>Grain & hay twice daily, daily turn-out, stalls cleaned & refreshed daily. Full stall board details available upon request.</i>	\$425/\$900 Per/mo
Pasture Board <i>Pasture rotation, clean water, salt/mineral block, grain & hay in winter months when pastures are limited.</i>	\$275/mo
Private Lesson (\$ Own/ \$ Lesson Horse) <i>Pre-purchase discount of 5% for 4 -OR- 10% for 8 lesson s</i>	\$40/\$45 <i>Due at time of lesson</i>
Group Lesson (\$ Own/ \$ Lesson Horse) <i>Pre-purchase discount of 5% for 4 -OR- 10% for 8 lesson s</i>	\$30/\$35 <i>Due at time of lesson</i>
Training <i>Per month at full, half or per ride rates in addition to boarding fee.</i>	\$350/per month \$250/2 x per week \$35/ride
Activity Fee <i>Any horse that is not in a training and/or lesson program will be assessed this fee. It CAN be applied towards lessons or training.</i>	\$100/mo
